- New Business of the Year was ECU Communications of Bristow. ECU Communications President Jackie Krick accepted the award. The chamber defines new businesses as those operating for three years or less and recognized a business with outstanding growth potential and or innovation.

- Mid-Size Business of the Year was_Herndon-based Telelink Communications. Telelink Communications President Cheryl Corser and her husband, Russ, accepted the award. The chamber defines mid-size businesses as those with between 10 and 50 employees.
- Large Business of the Year was Northern Virginia Community College. William Gary, NVCC vice president of workforce, accepted the award. The chamber defines large businesses as those with 51 employees or more.
- Pioneer of the Year, defined as a business using cutting edge practices, was For Health & Balance in Herndon. For Health & Balance owner Freddi Donner accepted the award.
- Chamber Impact Award went to Christine Mohr of the YMCA Fairfax County-Reston.
- The Chairman's Award went to _Mary Ann Oliver of Oliver & Oliver PC in Reston.
- The Public-Private Partnership Award went to the Metropolitan Washington Airports Authority "for their innovative solution towards rail in the Dulles Corridor," according to the release. New MWA Board member Michael O'Reilly, a lawyer and former Herndon mayor, accepted the award.
- The Public Service Award, "given to a public official for extraordinary efforts on behalf of the community" went to Dels. Tom Rust (R-86) and David Albo (R-42)) "for their efforts to promote a transportation solution through the Rust-Albo bill introduced this past fall," according to the release.
